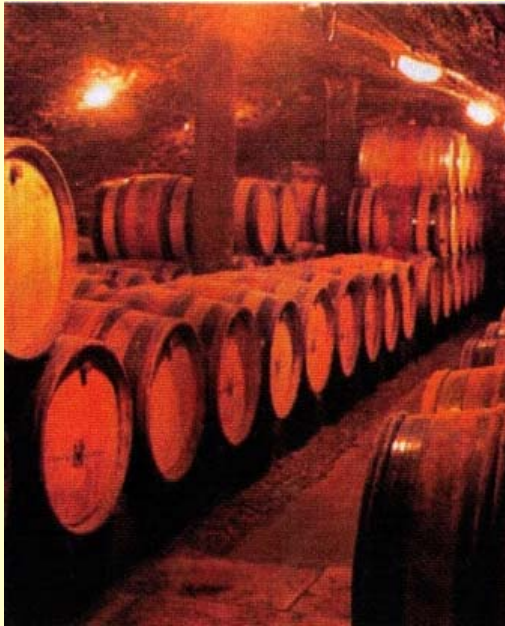

## *Itinerary:*

### *Sunday, 20th "Burgundy"*

Our first day in Burgundy . We will visit *The Fontenay Abbe*, one of the oldest Cistercian monasteries



in Europe. The magnificent Romanesque style structure founded in 1118 by St. Bernard, is located in a marshy Burgundy valley.

The *Château de Bussy-Rabutin* is undoubtedly an impressive building, but just as interesting is the story of its original owner, Roger de Bussy-Rabutin.

'Outrageous', 'scandalous' and 'flamboyant' are some of the more polite descriptions of this 15th century character.

### *Monday, 21<sup>st</sup>*

#### *"Cotes de Nuits"*

Visit two wineries in the renowned *Cotes de*



*Nuits*. Experience the beautiful villages of Gevrey Chambertin, Morey Saint Denis and Nuits Saint George. We will lunch at the quaint restaurant "La petite Auberge" in Vosne Romanée

## *Tuesday, 22nd "Cotes de Beaune"*



We will visit two wineries in the Famous *Cotes de Beaune*, and the beautiful City of

Beaune including the Hospices, Volney, Pommard and Meursault. We will tour a Cooperage, in the Haute Cotes de Beaune.

## *Wednesday, 23rd "Free day in semur"*



Sébastien's suggestions are included in the self guided tour provided to you of *Semur-en-*

*Auxois*, a commune of the Cote d'Or departement in eastern France. Semur en Auxois possesses a medieval fortification, built on pink granite bluff beautifully surrounded by the River Armancon.

## *Thursday, 24th*

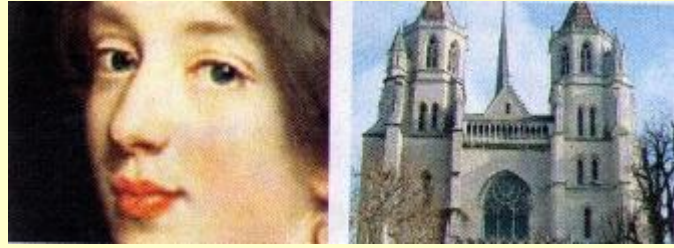
### *"Chablis"*

*Chablis* is notorious for its Limestone



Chardonnay, but also for its red roof city which we will tour along with two wineries; Cave Bailly and Laroche. The river Serein flows through the narrow-street village, making this place absolutely breathtaking.
